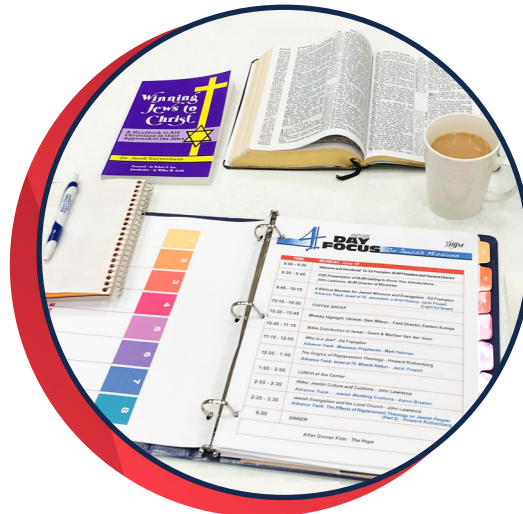
My favorite part about Four-Day Focus is the fellowship and getting to know other people who want to witness to Jewish people and learn more about their culture and background.
