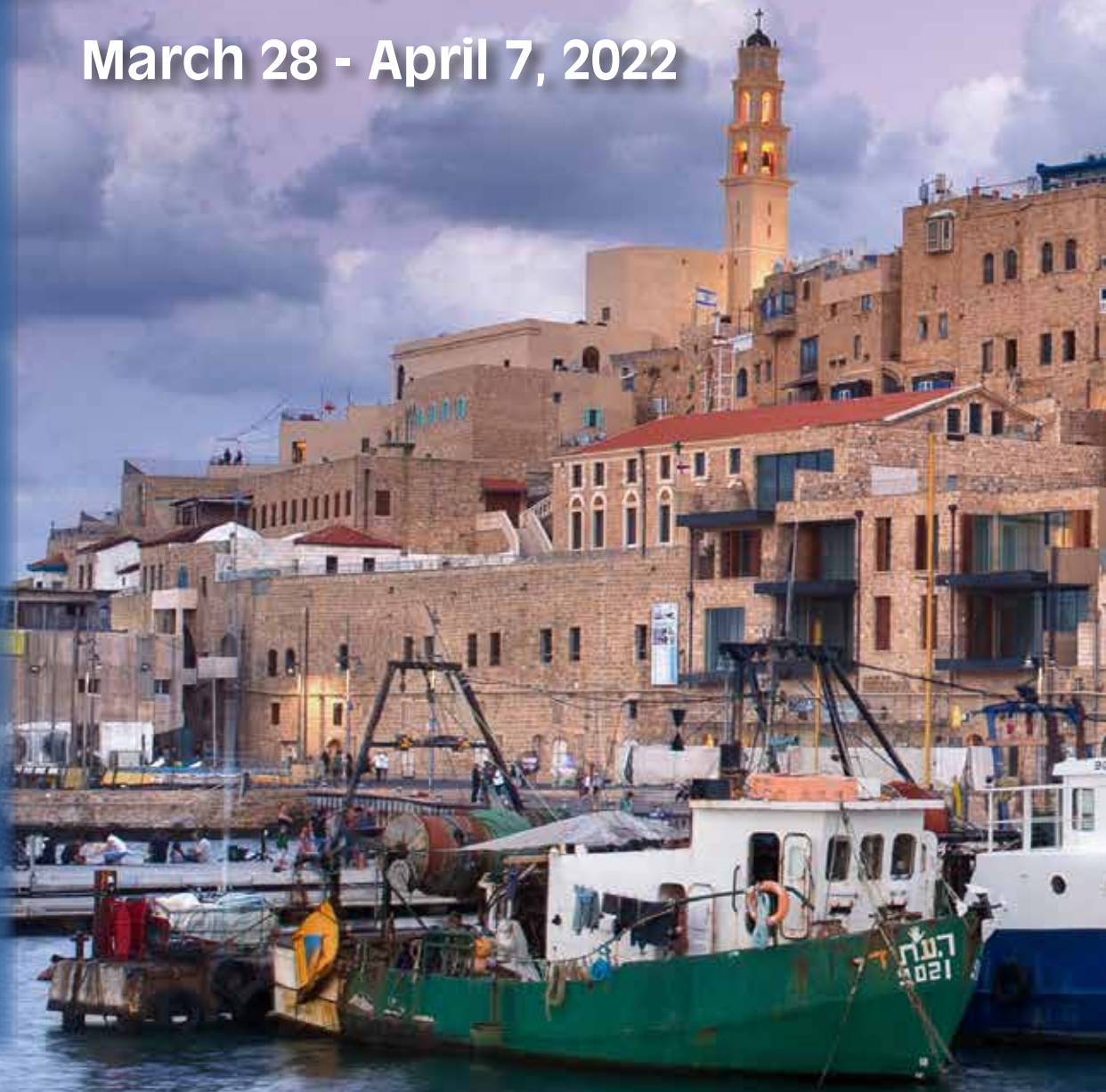

ISRAEL *Dan to Beersheba Study Tour*

Monday • March 28 – Depart from Atlanta, GA

March 29 – Arrive in Israel

Experience Project Nehemiah (a humanitarian outreach to Jewish immigrants) and the ancient seaport city of Jaffa (the house of Simon the Tanner). Overnight near the Mediterranean Coast in the city of Netanya.

March 30 – Sharon Plain & Jezreel Valley

Ancient Caesarea Maritime (where Peter preached the gospel to the household of Cornelius). Mount Carmel, the Jezreel Valley, and Megiddo (the site of 21 battles from the Old Testament and the final battle of Armageddon). Overnight at Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel on the Sea of Galilee.

March 31 – The Galilee

Nazareth (including the Nazareth Village, a wonderful re-creation of what the village would have looked like in biblical times), Capernaum, a cruise on the Sea of Galilee, Magdala (home of Mary Magdalene), and the Jordan River. Overnight at Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel.

April 1 – To the North – The Golan Heights

Mount of Beatitudes, the Dan Nature Preserve, the Headwaters of the Jordan River, Dan, Caesarea Philippi (Banias), and the Golan Heights. Overnight at Ginosar Kibbutz Hotel.

April 2 – The Jordan Valley & Dead Sea

The Jordan River, Qumran (where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered), and Ein Gedi (where David hid from King Saul). Overnight on the shores of the Dead Sea (David Resort).

April 3 – Masada and up to Jerusalem

Masada on the Dead Sea, The Israeli Museum (collections of centuries-old Israeli artifacts, including the Dead Sea Scrolls), Model of Jerusalem (a scale model of Jerusalem in the time of Christ), and Yad Vashem Holocaust Museum. Overnight at Sephardic House in Old City, Jerusalem.

April 4 – Jerusalem

Temple Mount, Wailing Wall, Kotel Tunnels, Temple Institute (site of the preparations being made for the rebuilding of the Temple), and the Burnt House. Overnight at Sephardic House in Old City, Jerusalem.

April 5 – Jerusalem

Mount Moriah, Dome of the Rock, Mount of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Pool of Bethesda, Stephen's Gate, Church of Saint Anne, Golgotha (place of the skull), Garden Tomb, and the Valley of Elah (where David slew Goliath). Overnight at Sephardic House in Old City, Jerusalem.

April 6 – Negev Desert and Journey Home

Home of David Ben Gurion (the first prime minister of the modern State of Israel), Ramon Crater, farewell dinner, and Ben Gurion Airport.

Thursday • April 7 – Journey home to the USA
